

NAMIBIA – 11 DAYS FLY & SELF-DRIVE



Day 1 Arrive at the Windhoek International Airport with flight, clear customs and immigrations. Upon arrival meet your Nature Friend Safaris transfer representative who will hand you a brochure pack with vouchers, maps and suggestions of things to do. Road transfer to the Elegant Guesthouse

Day 2 After enjoying breakfast, meet your Nature Friend Safaris transfer representative Road transfer to the Windhoek Eros Airport

Day 4

Board your flight to the coastal town of Swakopmund

On arrival, collect a hired car and drive to guest house. Perhaps you would like to
arrange an early (or packed) breakfast for the next morning with the hotel, as I suggest
getting an early start to Camp Kipwe (350km ± 5 hours on gravel road)

Day 5 Camp Kipwe (Dinner, Bed & Breakfast)

Taking advantage of the nearby Aba Huab River and all consuming expansive landscape, Kipwe offers a refreshing perspective on traditional safari life. - Day 7 After an early breakfast drive through to Etosha National Park (366km ± 4 hours)

 Okaukuejo RestCamp/Waterhole Chalet (Dinner, Bed & Breakfast)

Okaukuejo is located 17 km from the southern entrance of the park.

Okaukuejo camp is the oldest tourist camp in Etosha and it currently functions as the administrative hub of the park, and the home of the Etosha Ecological Institute. It is situated at the western end of the pan. Accommodation is provided to suit every need, in premier bush chalets overlooking the waterhole; bush chalets and double rooms; or family chalets. Other facilities include a restaurant, bar, shop, swimming pool, kiosk and camping facilities. The main attraction of this camp is that it overlooks a permanent waterhole which is floodlit at night. Here a wide diversity of wildlife congregates and interacts.

Day 8

Check out of camp after breakfast and continue through Etosha to Namutoni Rest Camp (as you will game view on the drive, be sure to check with the park officials before you leave as to the movement of game in the area)

At Namutoni there is a restaurant for a buffet dinner.

Namutoni RestCamp/Bush Chalet (Bed & Breakfast)

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Namutoni is situated on the eastern side of Etosha, and derives its name from the old German fort around which it is built. The presence of the fort gives Namutoni more character than the other rest camps in Etosha, and in terms of accommodation this is probably the best of the three rest camps. The Fort, which is for pedestrians only and overlooks the King Nehale waterhole, is the hub of activity with two restaurants, a relaxation lounge, a bar, crafts boutique, curio shop, jewelers and bookstore. An elevated decked walkway along the water-hole provides views of the surrounding scenery, wildlife and spectacular sunsets.

Day 9 After breakfast drive to the Waterberg Area (362km ± 4 hours)
There is a restaurant for all a carte dinner.

Waterberg RestCamp/Double room (Bed & Breakfast)

Waterberg Camp is the gateway to the Waterberg Plateau Park, one of the most spectacular features of the northern region, towering some 200 meters above the surrounding landscape, with sheer cliffs and fascinating rock formations.

The Waterberg Camp has recently been re-developed. Accommodation is provided in comfortable premier bush chalets, two and four bed bush chalets and double rooms, all nestled along the base of the Waterberg Plateau cliffs, amongst towering trees.

- Day 10 Enjoy the day at leisure or taking part in guided morning and afternoon game drive, guided or self-guided trails on the plateau or take a nature walk within the camp.

 Waterberg RestCamp/Double room (Bed & Breakfast)
- Day 11 Depart from Waterberg RestCamp and drive 335km (±4 hours) to the Windhoek airport. You need to be there by 13h30 to return rental car and connect with your outgoing flight.

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
