SUN CITY & JOHANNESBURG

Day 1

On arrival at Johannesburg's OR Tambo airport you will be met and transferred (2 hours) to Sun City Afternoon at leisure.

Overnight: The Palace of the Lost City (bed and breakfast)

Day 2

Day at leisure to explore the resort. Visit the Valley of Waves and the Casino.

Overnight: The Palace of the Lost City (bed and breakfast)

Day 3

After breakfast you will be collected at reception and transferred to the guest house in Johannesburg. En route you will stop at a traditional African Craft Market and an optional visit to the Elephant Sanctuary for interactions with elephants (costs on request).

Overnight: Melrose Place Guest House (bed and breakfast)

Day 4

After breakfast you will be met by your guide for a full day tour to Soweto and the Apartheid Museum. A traditional African lunch is included at Wandies in Soweto.

Overnight: Melrose Place Guest House (bed and breakfast)

Day 5

After breakfast you will be transferred to Johannesburg's OR Tambo airport for your flight home.

SUN CITY & PILANSBERG GAME RESERVE

Day 1

On arrival at Johannesburg's OR Tambo airport you will be met and transferred (2 hours) to Sun City Afternoon at leisure.

Overnight: The Palace of the Lost City (bed and breakfast)

Day at leisure to explore the resort. Visit the Valley of Waves and the Casino.

Day 3

After breakfast you will be collected at reception and transferred the Pilanesberg Game Reserve (near to Sun City). Arrive in time for lunch and in the late afternoon join your ranger on an open vehicle in search of the Big 5 on a game drive, returning to the lodge for dinner.

Overnight: Kwa-Maritane Bush Lodge (Dinner, bed and breakfast and one game drive daily)

Day 4

Enjoy an optional early morning hot air balloon flight over the game reserve (cost on request) and return to the lodge for breakfast and a day at leisure before going out on a game drive in the afternoon.

Day 5

After breakfast you will be transferred (2 hours) to Johannesburg's OR Tambo airport for your flight home.

CAPE TOWN

Day 1

Arrive at Johannesburg's OR Tambo airport and connect to Cape Town. On arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Afternoon at leisure.

Overnight: Cascades on the Promenade (bed and breakfast)

Day 2-4

Days at leisure to explore Cape Town. Below are some recommended day tours (pickup and drop off at your hotel). Costs given separately.

Day 5

After breakfast you will be met and transferred to Cape Town airport for your flight home.

Optional day tours:

FULL DAY PENINSULA SCENIC TOUR

We depart after picking you up at your hotel, along the spectacular Atlantic Seaboard. We drive through the coastal suburbs of Sea Point, Bantry Bay and Clifton. We will stop for a photo opportunity of Table Mountain's impressive Twelve Apostles. We then travel on past Bakoven and Llandudno which are marked by shipwrecks which fell foul to the infamous Cape winter storms, then on to the scenic fishing village of Hout Bay. An optional extra would be to board a boat to view the Cape Fur Seal colony on Duiker Island.

We will also head over the 600m heights of Chapman's Peak Drive, which is without a doubt one of the world's most spectacular mountain passes. You will also have a chance to watch Southern Right Whales frolicking just offshore from June to November.

Explore the rocky coastline and unique Cape Fynbos vegetation which is home to unique birdlife such as African Black Oystercatchers and Cape Sugarbirds amongst others. The opportunity is also there to view small animals such as the Cape Mountain Zebra, Bontebok, ostrich and Baboon as we enter the Cape of Good Hope National Park. Climb to the famous Cape Point Lighthouse to capture the magical vistas of False Bay, and stop at the south western most point of Africa - the fabled Cape of Good Hope. (A funicular is an optional extra for those who prefer).

Lunch (for your own account) will be at one of the restaurants of your choice after having been giving suggestions by your guide. We will visit Boulders Beach for an exciting close up encounter with African Penguins. Drive through the historical naval village of Simonstown and over yet another spectacular mountain pass; Boyes Drive, where you will take in views of the quaint fishing harbour at Kalk Bay as well as the seaside villages of St James and Muizenberg.

Visit Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens - with time to browse these magnificent gardens set on the slopes of Table Mountain before returning to the city.

FULL DAY WINELANDS TOUR

We depart the city to the Winelands region of Stellenbosch, Paarl and Franschoek for a leisurely exploration of these historic Wine Route towns.

Wine estates visited will vary according to client preferences, but the tour includes the region's major wine producing areas. The tastings include high quality (and often award winning) red and whites wines.

Lunch (for your own account) will be at one of the spectacular restaurants in the area where the chefs regularly receive awards for their outstanding cuisine.

There are many natural and historic heritage places in this area and your guide will take you past many sights like the Afrikaans Taal Monument amongst others. The majestic scenery in the area is unparalleled so even if you don't drink wine, the countryside and the history make it well worth the visit.

Stellenbosch, with its tree lined streets, historical architecture, alfresco cafes and good shopping is South Africa's second oldest town, while Franschoek is a food lovers delight and Paarl has the historical Taal monument to boast along with spectacular scenery.

Please note: Tours are subject to change in directions and Estates visited due to traffic and time constraints.

HALF DAY TABLE MOUNTAIN & CITY TOUR

We depart after picking you up at your hotel, for a comprehensive city orientation tour starting with a trip up Table Mountain by cable car (cableway ticket for own account). The state-of-the-art cable car rotates 360° on its way to the top, offering a panoramic view. At the summit are short walks to enjoy the magnificent scenery.

You are then taken on a city tour, which includes a visit to the Castle, a drive through the city centre, a stop in the picturesque Malay (Muslim) Quarter, the architecture in this area is typical of what Cape Town was like 200 years ago. Then visit to the Waterfront or Milnerton for views of Cape Town. You will go past the houses of parliament, visit two or three of our famous museums and visit the company gardens.

Lunch (for your own account) will be at one of the restaurants of your choice after having been giving suggestions by your guide. After lunch you will have time to explore the V&A waterfront which offers a wide range of shopping and entertainment experiences.

Please note that tours are subject to a change in direction due to weather, traffic and time restraints.

HALF DAY ROBBEN ISLAND TOUR

We depart from the hotel and make our way to the Clock Tower (Nelson Mandela Gateway) to board a ferry to the Island. The three and a half hour tour includes a return trip across Table Bay (30 minute ferry ride) a visit to the Maximum Security Prison, interaction with an ex-political prisoner and a 45 minute bus tour with a guide providing commentary.

Ferries depart at 9am, 11am, 1pm and 3pm, weather permitting, from the V & A Waterfront in Cape Town.

The Robben Island Tour includes:

- A return boat trip across Table Bay
- A visit to the infamous Maximum Security Prison
- Interaction with an ex-political prisoner
- A 45-minute bus ride with a guide providing commentary

You will have the opportunity to explore the Murray's Bay Harbour precinct attractions, such as the Muslim shrine, or kramat, and the Museum Shop.
